



Summary: The Canadian Safe Sport Program Privacy Policy

The Canadian Safe Sport Program (the "CSSP") is administered by the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (the "CCES") to uphold a respectful and safe sport culture across Canada. The CSSP is committed to advancing a sport environment that is inclusive, accessible, welcoming, and free from maltreatment. The CCES independently administers and enforces the Universal Code of Conduct to Prevent and Address Maltreatment in Sport (the "UCCMS") for federally funded Canadian sport organizations at the national level.

The CSSP Privacy Policy outlines the principles and practices for managing personal information within the context of the CSSP. This includes the types of personal information collected, the purposes for its collection, and the conditions under which it may be disclosed. The policy ensures that personal information is only used for the purposes for which it was collected, such as processing reports of maltreatment, conducting investigations, and implementing educational and preventive measures.

The CSSP Privacy Policy also details the rights of individuals regarding their personal information, including the right to access, amend, and object to the processing of their information. It describes the security measures in place to protect personal information, the retention and disposal policies, and the procedures for handling inquiries and complaints. The policy emphasizes the importance of obtaining consent and maintaining transparency in the collection and use of personal information.

The CCES is dedicated to protecting the privacy and personal information of all individuals involved in the CSSP. The policy ensures compliance with applicable privacy laws and regulations, as well as the UCCMS. It also highlights the CCES's commitment to continuous improvement and regular updates to its privacy practices to reflect changes in legislation, technology, and stakeholder needs.
